She holds the record for publishing the largest number of bestsellers in history, and she's best known for her entrepreneurial and innovative approach.

Developing her taste for a great story as a reporter and producer for various television shows and publications, including *Geraldo* and *Entertainment Tonight*, Judith Regan made an easy transition to book publishing. She rose through the ranks at Simon & Schuster, introducing bestseller after bestseller, and rose quickly to the position of Vice President and Senior Editor. In 1994, she created ReganBooks, her own imprint at the larger HarperCollins Publishers, and made history again creating the most successful imprint launch in decades.

Since then, Regan has stood beside her publishing axiom, "Not just the same old story," and is known for publishing bestselling, award-winning, and controversial books by notable authors. Regan has also won major design, cookbook, and literary fiction and non-fiction awards.

In addition to her position at the helm of ReganBooks, Regan found another storytelling platform hosting and as the host of Fox News Channel's *Judith Regan Tonight* for nine years. In 2003, she will be producing and hosting one hour specials for the FOX network as well as continuing to appear on the Fox News Channel. By conducting one-on-one interviews and heated roundtable discussions with a cross-section of celebrities and newsmakers, she provides on her audience with unique, varying perspectives on the issues of the day, covering current affairs, culture, politics, and entertainment.

As the host of a pop-culture series at New York City's 92nd St. Y, Regan interviews a variety of pop culture icons, from *The Sopranos*' Edie Falco to Academy Award® winning director and producer Sydney Pollack.

A graduate of Vassar College, Regan also produces for television and film. She lives in Manhattan, and is the mother of two.
